Psalms 119:130:

The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple.

Some of the ways we can maintain the light of God's Word in our minds are by reading His Word daily, praying, remembering what He has done for us, and staying faithful to do what we know is true. Proverbs 4:18:

Philippians 2:15,16:

To share anything with others, we must have it ourselves; that is why we must live in the light to shine bright. We reflect God's brilliance as we live in the light of His Word. It is our joy to faithfully live God's Word and hold it forth to others so they too can live in the light.

God's Word is the spiritual light that all men need to prevail in life. Let's live faithfully in the light of God's Word and shine as lights, overcoming the darkness around us and making the brilliant light of God available to others.

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
